EASE School for Manuscript Editors and Academic Authors

EASE training events are an excellent way of meeting journal editors and manuscript editors, learning from expert speakers, and joining multiple discussions on a range of topics. Many events are held virtually, enabling quick and inexpensive access to a wealth of knowledge.

This four-session online training course has been designed to help researchers, academics, technical writers, and copy editors who edit technical documents – especially research papers – to make them more acceptable to journal editors and publishers, less likely to be desk-rejected, and once accepted, be published ahead of other manuscripts.

The 12-hour course is held once a week spread over four weeks, with two topics covered each week over 3 hours:

- / Publishing in high-impact-factor journals: an overview
- / Handling quantitative expressions in running text
- / Organising numerical data into reader-friendly tables
- / Preparing impactful charts, graphs, and other illustrations
- / Mastering the minutiae of citations and references
- / Learning to be a more effective academic writer
- / Responding to reviewers' comments and avoiding plagiarism
- / Putting finishing touches to your written work.

The training will be led by Yateendra Joshi, who chairs the EASE Training Committee, and two guest speakers.

This course is particularly suitable for early-career researchers and manuscript editors but will benefit all those involved in writing and editing scientific documents irrespective of the level of experience and expertise.

Course Schedule and Booking

Sessions for this event are organised through EASE with support from its Regional Chapter network. The 12-hour course is divided into four sessions, one each week, for four weeks.

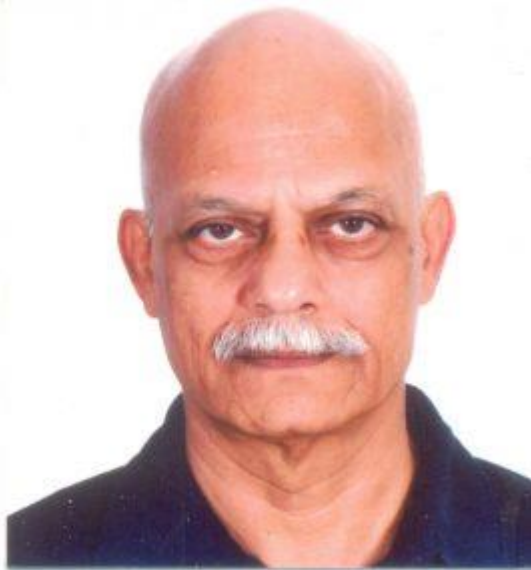
